ASRA'S ACTIVITIES

COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Under the CBR Program, ASRA extended its services to 1069 beneficiaries spread over 11 communities. The present staff strengths under CBR program is 20+.

- Medical Intervention & Therapeutic Services were provided to 322 beneficiaries.
- Under CBR Education program: 293 children are learning education out of which there are 34 CwDs.
- Under Vocational Trainings Program: 52 students are getting vocational trainings.
- Seed Loan Program: 01 beneficiaries received Seed Loan & 03 more have been identified.
- Online applications were applied for: over 81 C/PwDs.
- Beneficiaries covered under psychometric assessment & psychotherapy project: over 45 C/PwDs.
- Beneficiaries who were provided with skills development training in Art & Craft & Artificial Jewellry Making: 229 beneficiaries in 10 communities.
- ASRA CBR-Team was participated in a Disability/UDID and Assessment Camp organized by Department of Social Welfare-South West Delhi & 46 Children/Persons with Disabilities beneficiaries registered at ASRA counter for availing Government facilities.

AIRTC SPECIAL SCHOOL

The present staff strength under AIRTC Special School is 07.

- During the quarter under report, activities were organized in AIRTC Special School for **17 children** enrolled in it by special educators / trainers. These activities were designed as per the interests and capabilities of the students.
- As per the Delhi Government all schools were closed due to poor air quality from 18th Nov - 30th Nov, 2024. That period, AIRTC Special School Educator conducted surveys and provide their services in the ASRA's adopted slum communities at ASRA Education Centre for the better performance of the students.
- **AIRTC New Initiative-** Another new initiative taken by AIRTC Special School is introduction to Pre-vocational classes.



CUTTING AND TAILORING COURSE

Tailoring Program in **Shiv Vihar, Jwalapuri & Nangli Dairy** communities continued with **34 enrolled needy students**. Regular classes are being conducted in all the Centres where all students are pursuing their course.



COMPUTER COURSE

Computer Training Course is conducted at CBR Project Office in **Pappankalan & Hoshiyarpur, Noida** community. In Pappankalan community, the computer teacher is Ms. Asha, a person with disability who lives in Pappankalan community. Total **8 students** have been enrolled during the quarter under report.



MOBILE REPAIRING COURSE

Under the **Mobile Repairing Course**, new batch of needy students from lower economic strata were enrolled in **Shiv Vihar** Community during the quarter under report. Regular classes are being conducted, **10 students** have been enrolled in the course & training is in progress.



BEAUTY CULTURE COURSE

This course has been started since the **3rd week of December 2024** in the newly revived community at **Bindapur**, comprising of **3-4 students**. The trainer under this course gives the overall skill and training to the students who are passionate to learn and contribute in this field.





1.3 SOCIAL MAPPING IN CBR, AIRTC AND ARTC



Community Based Rehabilitation

Social Mapping of children/persons with disabilities in CBR, AIRTC Special School & ARTC is being done with an objective to do their socio-economic assessment eventually leading towards their inclusion in society. Simultaneously, online applications were continuously filled by ASRA CBR Team, for those, who were uneducated, or ignorant of how to apply through online process to avail Government facilities. During the quarter under report, ASRA CBR Team online applications applied for Government facilities such as disability certificate (DC), unique disability identity card (UDID), Disability Pension & E-ticket card, for 81 C/PwDs.



1.4 SEED LOAN PROGRAM

Community Based Rehabilitation

The purpose of this program is to promote financial independence and help disabled persons living in slums to earn their livelihood and improve their quality of life. The beneficiaries of this program are exclusively persons with disabilities who are needy and want to be self-reliant. With the help of Seed Loan, they either purchase additional material for their respective enterprise or start a new enterprise which helps them to increase their monthly income. During the quarter under report, one PwD beneficiary namely, Mr. Tek Singh from Pappankalan slum community, who is orthopedialy challenged received Seed Loan for purchased sewing machine for expension of his small boutique.

The total number of beneficiaries under Seed Loan program is now 146.







1.5 DISABILITY CAMP

Community Based Rehabilitation



ASRA CBR-Team was participated in a Disability/UDID and Assessment Camp organized by Department of Social Welfare-South West Delhi under Sugamya Sahayak Scheme for person with disabilities on 6th Dec 2024 at Rao Tula Ram Hospital, Jaffarpur, New Delhi. **Total 46 Children/Persons with Disabilities beneficiaries registered at ASRA counter for availing Government facilities. 39 beneficiaries out of 46 are from ASRAs adopted south-west slum communities.**

ASRA Intervention, Recreation and Therapy Centre (AIRTC)

In AIRTC, apart from special education, all students enrolled in AIRTC are getting comprehensive rehabilitation which includes assessment by Orthopedic Surgeon and customized, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and Prosthetics & Orthotics by qualified professionals.

The students enrolled in AIRTC have different types of disabilities, predominantly intellectual disabilities associated with physical & speech & hearing impairments. **During the quarter under report, 17 children with special need attended the ASRA Special School. ASSESSMENT CLINIC

The assessment clinic consists of a Senior Orthopedic Surgeon who has been visiting ASRA once a week since May 2022 and a team of experts / professionals comprising of Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapist, Speech Therapist, Special Educators, Prosthetic & Orthotic Engineer & Psychologist etc. After a thorough assessment is made, the patient is evaluated for specific treatment with specified duration and referred to the concerned department of ARTC and other hospitals and Rehab Centers for the needful treatment. Patients are visiting ARTC both from the surrounding areas and adopted communities.
