With this support, the ASRA team, after much thinking and brainstorming sessions together, evolved a detailed 5 year long term Action Plan. The targets were set on monthly, quarterly, yearly basis spread over 5 years. Hence the ASRA Vision 2027 evolved.

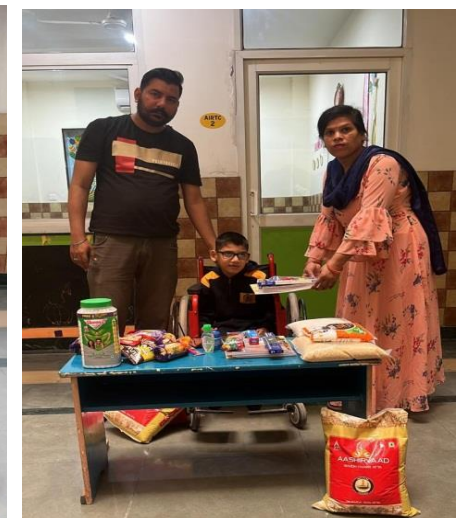

## CBR EDUCATION CENTRES

One new education centre was opened at Jwalapuri community from 14<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Additionally, ASRA's Education program continues in its adopted slum communities namely Shiv Vihar, Pappankalan and Hoshiyarpur NOIDA. Steps were initiated towards identifying & enrolling children who were interested in continuing their studies under the Education program. 55 children including 13 CwDs at Shiv Vihar education centre, 16 children including 03 CwD at Pappankalan education centre, 36 children including 01 CwDs at Hoshiyarpur NOIDA, 19 children at Jwalapuri education centre continued their education during the quarter under report.

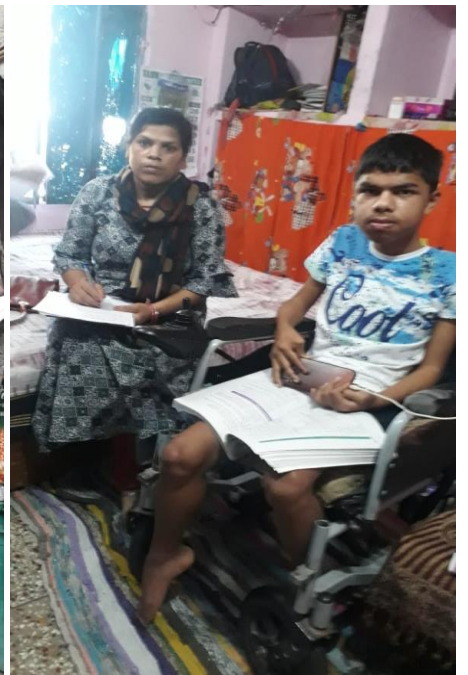

### **MEDICAL UNIT AT ARTC**

- a. **ASSESSMENT CLINIC:** A person with disability always requires more care and attention so that he/she is able to cope up with his or her condition. Each person who required treatment comes to the Assessment Clinic first. Clinical assessment to use to promote and enhance patient's wellbeing by accomplishing effective solution to the problems they are facing.

Assessment clinic includes **Senior Orthopedic Surgeon** who visits ASRA once a week since May 2022 and a team of experts / professionals comprising of **Senior Physiotherapist & her team, Senior Occupational Therapist & her team, Speech Therapist, Special Educators and Prosthetic & Orthotic Engineer.** After a thorough assessment is made, the patient is evaluated for specific treatment with specified duration and referred to the concerned departments of ARTC and other Hospitals and Rehab Centers for the needful. **Patients are visiting ARTC both from the surrounding areas and adopted communities.**

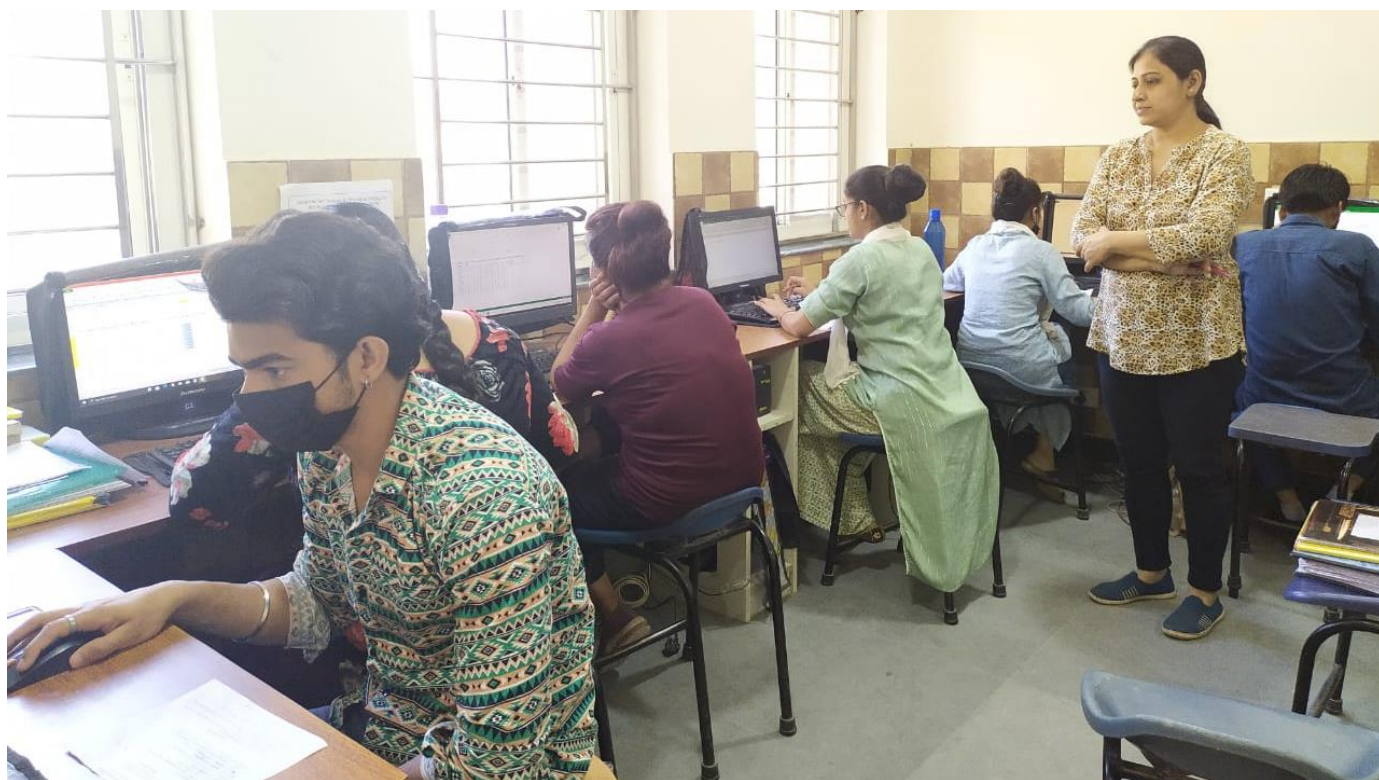

**VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN TAILORING AND HANDICRAFT TRAINING AT ARTC**  
**(RECOGNIZED BY NIOS, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA)**

**Tailoring & Fashion Designing Courses at ARTC**

Vocational Trainings Unit started Tailoring course at ASRA Head Office in Oct'2008, Beauty Culture Course in Oct'2008 & Fashion Designing Course in May'2010. It consists four experienced and hardworking teachers who provide training to students-basic to advance. It got accreditation in 4 courses (3 of tailoring & 1 of beauty culture) from National Institute of Open Schooling in Nov'2013.
